# **Signing Up for Green Team Tee Times**

### I. Sign-Up Time Frames & Schedule

Please remember, the Starters at the golf courses are not to make any Green Team changes. Members must email <u>greenteam@suncitywest.com</u> with request for cancellations, additions, or changes of any type.

#### > June 18, 2022 - Stardust Golf Course

- o This Google form has closed and sent to Data Entry.
- You should have received your confirming email from Data Entry/Golf Ops this past weekend. If not, you can verify your tee time via your Portal Account or by calling the golf course and giving them your rec card number and asking them to do a search.
- EMAIL <u>greenteam@suncitywest.com</u> TO CANCEL OR REQUEST TO BE ADDED TO A TEE TIME. <u>Do NOT call the golf course</u>. A Green Team Coordinator will then make changes.
- YOU MUST INCLUDE YOUR REC CARD NUMBER <u>WITH ALL</u> <u>EMAILS</u> and INCLUDE YOUR TEE TIME IF YOU ARE CANCELING. If this information is not included in your email, your change will be delayed or unable to be completed.

- o Sign-Up on the Google form is available on the SCW Website.
- Deadline for signing-up on this Google form will be noon on Thursday June 16<sup>th</sup>, <u>Or</u> sooner if all slots fill up. Email the Green Team if you have any questions regarding your sign-up.
- You should receive your confirming email from Data Entry/Golf Ops sometime on Sunday, June 19, 2022. If not, you can verify your tee time <u>after Sunday</u>, <u>June 19<sup>th</sup></u> via your Portal Account or by calling the golf course and giving them your rec card number and asking them to do a search.
- AFTER THE DEADLINE FOR SIGNING-UP ON THIS GOOGLE FORM, EMAIL greenteam@suncitywest.com TO CANCEL OR REQUEST TO BE ADDED TO A TEE TIME. Do NOT call the golf course. A Green Team Coordinator will then make changes.
- YOU MUST INCLUDE YOUR REC CARD NUMBER <u>WITH ALL</u> <u>EMAILS</u> and INCLUDE YOUR TEE TIME IF YOU ARE CANCELING. If this information is not included in your email, your change will be delayed or unable to be completed.

If you have not read them, you must, and if you have, it is a good idea to review them on a periodic basis.

# IV. Green Team

### Reminders

- Members must arrive thirty (30) minutes prior to their tee time. This allows for early start times when the Starter can call you out early, allows for all players in your group to take care of cart assignments (who is riding with who, etc.), and Green Team to rearrange players if needed.
- If you reserve an 18-hole tee time, please remember you must pay for an 18-hole tee time. Do we make exceptions? Yes, but on an as needed basis and arrangements are made prior to day of play.
- Under no circumstances are players allowed to drive golf carts
   between the green and a bunker! Golf carts are to remain 30 feet away
   from the green. Players with a medical flag can drive 15 feet closer,
   but not on the green or between bunkers.
- Be cautious when removing the flag from the hole and replacing it back in the hole so as not to damage the perimeter of the hole.
- o Only one practice shot is allowed.
- Do not spend more than a couple of minutes looking for lost balls.
- If your ball goes in the water, your next shot is from the "drop zone."

 All players are to go "on deck" either when the starter calls you "on deck" or when the tee time prior to yours is called to the tee box. Remember, do NOT proceed to the tee box from "on deck" until the starter calls you to the tee box.
