To avoid potential "***misunderstandings***", we have these rules:

1. Use the "**touch-move** rule".
2. If castling, move your king **first**.
3. You must play **at least 4** games with **different** opponents.
4. Mute electronic devices.
5. No kibitzing & no eating, but water bottles are OK.
6. Chess clocks are optional.

Points per game:

WIN	=	1	point
TIE	=	1/2	point
LOSE	=	0	points

Any incomplete game at 3PM will be adjudicated by other players.

Average scores will be posted at 3:30PM.
