Human Resources

- There were no new employee covid cases reported for the week of 2/14 or 2/21 2022.
- CDC Mask Requirements: The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) announced new mask guidance on February 25, 2022. Most of the U.S. population is at low or medium risk for COVID-19, and the agency has given the green light to take off masks. Community Levels can be low, medium, or high and are determined by looking at hospital beds being used, hospital admissions, and the total number of new COVID-19 cases in an area. Maricopa County community level is currently medium; therefore, people may choose to mask at any time. People with symptoms, a positive COVID-19 test, or exposure to someone with COVID-19 should wear a mask. The Recreation Centers of Sun City West (RCSCW) continues to follow the CDC guidelines and at this time, employees and volunteers are no longer required to wear masks indoors. The decision to wear a mask is a personal one, so please respect each individual's choice Maricopa County levels will be reviewed periodically and if the level increases to high, masks will be mandated indoors once again.
