

RECREATION CENTERS OF SUN CITY WEST, INC.
POLICY STATEMENT – B2
Senior Non-resident Bowling

1.0 General:

1.1. This policy establishes the parameters by which non-residents of Sun City West may participate in bowling activities and/or events in the Sports Pavilion.

1.2 Senior Non-residence are defined as those individuals forty five (45) years of age or older living in a neighboring community as designated by the General Manager.

2.0 Authority:

The General Manager shall be responsible for the implementation of this policy, as authorized in accordance with bylaw 4.18.17.

3.0 Policy:

The Sports Pavilion Manager, under the direction of the General Manager, shall grant approval for senior non-resident bowling based on eligibility, availability of open lanes and league vacancies.

3.1 Residents of Sun City West shall have priority over non-residents during open bowling, and for the filling of new vacancies on any team or league composed primarily of Sun City West residents according to the procedures established by the Sports Pavilion Manager and approved by the General Manager.

3.2 The Sports Pavilion Manager shall determine the eligibility of league members prior to granting approval for participation.

3.3 Participation by a qualified senior non-resident bowler may be as a member of a league team, an entrant in play or as an individual in open bowling.

4.0 Fee:

4.1 Participants in senior non-resident bowling shall pay a fee established by the Governing Board to participate in bowling activities. Senior non-resident bowlers will be issued a card to allow them to open bowl at the guest rate established by the Governing Board.

4.2 All other non-residents permitted to use the bowling facility shall pay the “Guest” fee established by the Governing Board.
