Asset Preservation Fees

• For the month of June 2021 there have been 33 APFs collected with 2 refunds vs. a total of 75 APFs for the same time frame in June 2020.

Sports Pavilion

- During week 1, Lizard Acres Pub saw just over \$900 in revenue, week 2, it increased to \$1,200 and this past Friday night, 78 ladies from a local group had a gathering at the Pub.
 \$500 in beer and wine were sold. We are still waiting on some furniture to be delivered.
 Sales of draft beer is going well.
- A new Wednesday League was established which consists of 16 teams.
- 246 VIP Passes have been sold at the Sports Pavilion in 2021 as compared to 180 last year.
- We will be hosting 180 women with the Arizona State Bowlerettes on Saturday 6/12/21.

B & F - Membership

- As a year-end reminder, staff needs to get all 20/21FY information to Accounting by June 30, 2021.
- We are ready for staff to roll on Capital Project items beginning July 1, 2021.
- APF Fees collected for the month of May have been the highest ever.

Golf Operations

- For the first 6 days of June:
 - Rounds of Golf Rounds are up 3% (93 rounds) vs. FY 2020.
 - ➢ Revenue for green fees and cart fees are up by − 23% vs. FY 2020.
- Group Play We currently have 34 separate groups being scheduled for the summer months. Prepping the July and August schedule and looking to have it published in the nest 10-12 days.
- We are working with HR to modify existing employee configuration in Golf Ops as well as reviewing golf course personnel breakout. We are trying to find additional ways to be more efficient and effective.
- Stardust Golf Course closed for the summer starting Monday June 7th and will reopen Tuesday, October 19th.

Golf / Landscape Maintenance

- Deer Valley is closed for aerification and reopens on June 8, 2021.
- Pebblebrook is scheduled to close for aerification Thursday, 6-10-21. The Course will reopen on Tuesday June 15th.
- Stardust Golf Course is closed for summer maintenance. Staff will be leveling tees, planting new trees and other small in-house projects during this time.
- Golf course palm tree trimming crews will be at Pebblebrook this Thursday 6-10-21.
 The Pebblebrook Putting Green renovation project was completed last Thursday,
 June 3rd. Reopening is scheduled for mid/late August.
- The Johnson Lawn Bowl greens were laser leveled last Thursday, June 3. Green No. 3 is back open for play. The other greens are scheduled to reopen on June 16th.
- The Bell Road Beautification Project has started. This is a PRIDES Project coordinated by Landscape Maintenance Staff and is completely funded by the PRIDES. This Project includes new irrigation along with all new plant materials (bougainvillea and yellow bells) to be planted along the outer RHJ walls. We understand that getting permits for this project are still several weeks out.

Clubs / CC & R's / Tours & Scheduling

- Meeting with Woodworking Club this week regarding special projects.
- CC&R violation numbers are dropping. There are only 7 CC&R investigations on the list for Monday 6/7/21. Current violations are at 54 and 44 are related to lawn maintenance and weeds.
