

# Special Edition of the Rec Center News

The Recreation Centers of Sun City West has scheduled a Recall Election for Monday, Aug. 16, following the Association's receipt of a Petition signed by at least 1,000 Owner Members, as required by Arizona law and our Bylaws.

## NOTICE OF RECALL ELECTION

The petition calls for the recall of Director Lou Mancuso. It states the following reasons:

1. On June 4th, and June 10th, Lou Mancuso's, unprofessional, condescending, intimidating and bullying personality is on display for the governing board, general manager, and the community residents in attendance of these meetings.
2. Change Clubs tax status from 501(c)7 Non-Profit, to 501(c)4, For-Profit. This opens all SCW clubs and all facilities to the general public for a fee.
3. Voted "NO" to RRP changes to help the clubs in SCW be Non-Profit 501(c)7 tax compliant.
4. He is calling for a recall of Directors Sue Fitzsimons and Donna Maloney due to the fact they voted "Yes" on the RRP changes to help the clubs in SCW be Non-Profit 501(c)7 tax compliant.
5. Purchase Hillcrest Golf Course without water rights, which will lower SCW Reserves.
6. Purchase 53 acres at the end of Deer Valley Road for a walking park.
