### **Human Resources**

- There were three new employee and 7 Club COVID cases reported this week.
- RCSCW COVID Task Force continues to meet as necessary to evaluate the latest information from the Arizona Dept. of Health and the CDC and prepare updated guidelines. We are currently mandating employees/volunteers wear masks when dealing with residents and/or outside guests or when they leave their workstations. If they maintain a 6 ft. distance from other employees, a mask is not mandated. Plexiglass shields have been reinstated where they were previously located.
- The stay on the ruling for OSHA Rules for vaccinations was lifted and this week employers are being instructed to comply with the new rules beginning Jan.10. 2022.
   The case is still with the Supreme Court in a challenge to the ruling.

- Financials For the month of January 2022
  - Golf Rounds are down 8% vs. January 2021.

  - Cold and wet weather are the culprits for the reduction in rounds of golf.
- Men's Round Robin Match Play Topurnament Hosted at Trail Ridge Golf Course and completed on Sunday. 72 players with (5) nine-hole matches played on Saturday and Sunday. See attached result sheet for winners. Next event which is a Two-Person Scramble, will be held on Saturday, January 22, 2022 at Grandview Golf Course.
- <u>Green Team Items</u> Beginner clinics have been scheduled for January through March. On January 6<sup>th</sup> we hosted a beginner golf presentation at the RH Johnson Lecture hall. The next one is January 11<sup>th</sup>. This is to help explaining the RCSCW golf rules and golf etiquette. This will be followed by an on-course demonstration of material covered. Five dates for the on-course demonstrations at Stardust are: January 12<sup>th</sup>.
- <u>HIO's for 2021</u> 185 hole-in-ones were made at RCSCW golf courses. The longest yardage was 199 and shortest was 76 yards.
