



New Motorized Golf Cart Rules

Beginning June 1st, 2022

With the purpose of maximizing our golfer's enjoyment and minimizing the cart traffic on the seven RCSCW golf courses, the following motorized cart policy will be implemented beginning Wednesday, June 1st, 2022.

With the advent of the one-person cart, which were made popular during the COVID-19 pandemic, the following examples should help the golfer determine what is best for their golf group.

Definitions:

Two Person Cart = 2 seats with 4 tires

One Person Cart = 1 seat with 2 or 3 tires

Motorized Cart Options for Each Group Size:

*Maximum group size per tee-time is Four Players

Medical Flag Participants will be asked to pair up with golfers in their group to comply with rules above.

If there is a walker/pull cart user in the group, subtract walker/pull care golfer(s) from the group size to get appropriate number of motorized carts in group.
