## **Golf Course Maintenance/Landscape Management**

#### **General Course Maintenance:**

- General Course Maintenance will continue at the three courses that are open (Trail Ridge Desert Trails and Grandview).
- Overseeding Update (Pebblebrook, Stardust, Deer Valley, and Echo Mesa). Courses will reopen on Tuesday 10/25.
  - Over the weekend Echo Mesa, Deer Valley and Stardust started first cuts on new ryegrass.
  - Pebblebrook is a couple of days behind due to high winds last week. Staff should be able to start mowing around Tuesday or Wednesday of this week.
  - We had a mainline water break at Echo Mesa Saturday afternoon. Repair work is scheduled this morning.
  - All four courses are scheduled to reopen on Tuesday, October 25<sup>th</sup>.
- Grandview Irrigation and Turf Reduction Project Update Areas on the back nine were sprayed and are dying off. These are areas that will be converted over to desert landscaping as part of the Irrigation and Turf Reduction Program. The Project is scheduled to start in April of 2023.

### Landscape Maintenance:

- Landscape Maintenance crews have removed summer flowers. Winter flowers will be going in.
- General Landscape Overseeding:
  - The Ball Park was mowed for the first time last Friday and is scheduled to reopen Tuesday, Oct. 18<sup>th</sup>.
  - Automotive Restoration Club lawn was seeded last Friday, Sept. 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - Lawn Bowls Overseeding: Staff seeded courts 1 & 2 on Wednesday of last week. Germination has already taken place.
