- We plan to make an offer on the Help Desk position this week.

- We are planning a POS (Point of Sale) software upgrade in the next week or two once Golf and Membership complete testing.
- IT Network Administrator, Gregg Bond, has worked with COX to complete the installation of the 8 LTE circuits for the Clubs Network. This is the cellular backup service we are implementing as part of our network upgrades. One thing to note is that the cellular service will only provide 10 Mbps download speed and 2 Mbps upload speed compared to our current 25x5 or 50x10 circuits. The LTE is meant as a temporary backup.
- Gregg is currently working with COX on conversion to the three fiber circuits which will take some time. We still have SD-WAN project as well. This will require changing the IPs of all the public wi-fi Apps. This work is planned for Nov. 21. Staff can expect the iPad time clocks to be down during this transition. Time clocks will be the first priority to get back up and running. Public wi-fi will be the 2<sup>nd</sup> priority. Members should expect wi-fi to be unavailable during the day.
- Per Sports Pavilion Manager, Barry Hardesty, the lizardacrespub.com website is not being used enough to justify its maintenance. We will remove that site but will hold on to the URL. We will make that URL a forwarding address to the Sports Pavilion/Lizard Acres page on the updated website.
