Signing Up for Green Team Tee Times

I. Sign-Up Time Frames & Schedule

Please remember, the Starters at the golf courses are not to make ANY Green Team changes.

AFTER THE DEADLINE FOR SIGNING-UP ON ANY OF THE GOOGLE FORMS, Green Team Members must EMAIL greenteam@suncitywest.com **TO CANCEL OR REQUEST TO BE ADDED TO A TEE TIME. Do NOT call the golf course.** A Green Team Coordinator will then make changes.

YOU MUST INCLUDE YOUR REC CARD NUMBER WITH ALL EMAILS, INCLUDE YOUR TEE TIME IF YOU ARE CANCELING, and SPECIFY 18- or 9-HOLES IF YOU ARE REQUESTING A TEE TIME. If this information is not included in your email, your change will be delayed or unable to be completed.

- **February 25, 2023 – Stardust Golf Course**
 - This Google form has closed and sent to Data Entry.
 - You should have received your confirming email from Data Entry/Golf Ops this past weekend. If not, you can verify your tee time via your Portal Account or by calling the golf course and giving them your rec card number and asking them to do a search.
 - Whether you receive a confirming email from Data Entry/Golf Ops, you should ALWAYS verify your tee time sometime during the week prior to the day of play.

- **March 4, 2023 – Stardust Golf Course starting on the back 9.**
 - Sign-Up on the Google form is available on the SCW Website.
 - **Deadline for signing-up on this Google form will be at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 23, 2023, or sooner if all slots fill up.** Email the Green Team if you have any questions regarding your sign-up.
 - You should receive your confirming email from Data Entry/Golf Ops sometime on Sunday, February 26, 2023. If not, you can verify your tee time **after Sunday February 26, 2023,** via your Portal Account or by calling the golf course and giving them your rec card number and asking them to do a search.
 - Whether or not you receive a confirming email from Data Entry/Golf Ops, you should ALWAYS verify your tee time sometime during the week prior to the day of play.

- **March 11, 2023 – Stardust Golf Course**
 - Sign-Up on the Google form will be available on the SCW Website by end of day on Monday February 20, 2023.

- **Deadline for signing-up on this Google form will be at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 2, 2023, Or sooner if all slots fill up.** Email the Green Team if you have any questions regarding your sign-up.
 - You should receive your confirming email from Data Entry/Golf Ops sometime on Sunday, March 5, 2023. If not, you can verify your tee time **after Sunday March 5, 2023,** via your Portal Account or by calling the golf course and giving them your rec card number and asking them to do a search.
 - Whether or not you receive a confirming email from Data Entry/Golf Ops, you should ALWAYS verify your tee time sometime during the week prior to the day of play.
- **March 18, 2023 – Echo Mesa Golf Course**
- Sign-Up on the Google form will be available on the SCW Website by end of day on Thursday, February 23, 2023.
 - **Deadline for signing-up on this Google form will be at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 9, 2023, Or sooner if all slots fill up.** Email the Green Team if you have any questions regarding your sign-up.
 - You should receive your confirming email from Data Entry/Golf Ops sometime on Sunday, March 12, 2023. If not, you can verify your tee time **after Sunday March 12, 2023,** via your Portal Account or by calling the golf course and giving them your rec card number and asking them to do a search.
 - Whether or not you receive a confirming email from Data Entry/Golf Ops, you should ALWAYS verify your tee time sometime during the week prior to the day of play.

Green Team 101

The Green Team 101 Program is open to all Green Team golfers. We recommend that all members attend this program. It was created to help facilitate the sharing of information to a beginner golfer and to reinforce this same information for all of you that are not beginners. No matter which type of golfer you are, you know there is a plethora of golf information to absorb and apply and sometimes it takes time and constant reminders to understand all the nuances that golf requires

GT101 is a two-part program with a Presentation being the first part and the second part is an On-Course Review. The golf rules, policies and etiquette discussed in the presentation often gets lost on not only the new golfer, but all other golfers as well. The On-Course Reviews will help drive the lessons home. These will take place on Stardust Golf Course late in the day. You will not golf, but a Green Team Mentor will walk (or drive) you through one or two holes.

Reminders for Green Team Saturday players

- TO CANCEL A TEE TIME DURING THE WEEK **OR** ON A SATURDAY MORNING, EMAIL THE GREEN TEAM at greenteam@suncitywest.com. Do **NOT** call the golf course or Golf Operations.
- Arrive 30 minutes prior to your tee time on a GT Saturday.
- Go to "On Deck" when the tee time prior to yours is called to the tee box.
- Do **NOT** go to the tee box **UNTIL** the starter calls you to the tee box.
- If you cannot see the group in front of you, your group is lagging. Pick up your ball and take it to the green and putt out to catch up.
- If it takes you more than 5 strokes to get to the green, do one of the following:
 - ✓ On the par 4 holes, tee off on the green tees.
 - ✓ Pick up your ball and carry it to the green.
 - ✓ Play best ball with your partner.

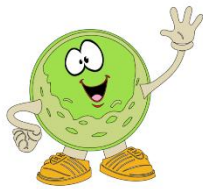
