Credit card migration is going well and will continue this week.

Cox will be working on their circuits at Palm Ridge and Deer Valley, which have been notoriously problematic for us for a number of years. So this is good news for the long run. In the short run, we can expect short impacts to service at PR and DV only July 25 and Aug. 1. Because we have our rollover circuit, we will not be down, just slower on the backup circuit for up to 30 minutes between midnight and 8 a.m. July 25; and 6 a.m. and 2 p.m. Aug. 1. The exact time is unknown. All affected staff have been notified.
