## **Weather in Southern Utah and Northern Arizona in April**

The temperature averages in the mid-60's for the high and in the low 40's for the low. Be sure to bring a jacket and sweater for cooler weather. The dress code is casual. Please don't forget to bring comfortable walking shoes. Altitude in Moab - 4,026 feet, Bryce Canyon - 7,894 feet, Page AZ - 4350 feet

### **Day One: Saturday, April 20, 2024**

Depart Sun City West, RH Johnson parking lot, aisles 8 & 9 at 7:30 AM. On our way to Kayenta AZ we will be visiting the Petrified Forest National Park near Holbrook. Here you will see one of the largest petrified wood deposits in the world. More than 13,000 years of human history and culture can be found in the park—from prehistoric peoples to the Civilian Conservations corps, from early explorers to Route 66 motorists, there are many stories to be told. We will arrive at the Hampton Inn Kayenta in time for a delicious welcome dinner at their Reuben Heflin Restaurant. **Your entrée selection is needed at time of booking: 1) Flat Iron Steak, 2) Wild Caught Salmon, or 3) Rosemary Chicken.** Kick back and relax this evening with new-made friends.

### **Day Two: Sunday, April 21, 2024**

Early breakfast buffet (included) at the hotel before departing for Goulding's Lodge for our Monument Valley Jeep Tour. Our tour includes the famous 17-mile loop, along with some restricted back-country stops. You will see the iconic Mittens and Three Sisters Viewpoints, along with some limited access stops such as the Sun's Eye and Ear of the Wind. Be sure to wear comfortable walking shoes and bring your camera. After our tour, we will head back to the lodge for lunch. You may want to try their popular Navajo Taco. Next, we are on our way to Moab and our 2 night stay at Elements Hotel. This evening you will be free to relax at the hotel and enjoy a sandwich or salad in their lounge or if you want to check out a local restaurant from their bustling downtown, transportation will be provided (dinner on own).

### **Day Three: Monday, April 22, 2024**

Breakfast (included) at the hotel this morning. Today we have a fun-filled day exploring the beautiful Arches and Canyonlands National Parks with our local expert step-on guide. You can sit back and enjoy all the spectacular scenery as our guide takes us on an incredible journey through the parks. Arches has over 2,000 natural stone arches and hundreds of soaring pinnacles, while Canyonlands preserves a colorful landscape eroded into numerous canyons, mesas, and buttes by the Colorado and Green Rivers. The stunning views are at every turn. This evening we are all going to "UnWine'd & Dine" on the Colorado River, as we watch the canyon walls drift past while listening to a live band and sipping on a glass of wine (beer or soft drinks also offered). Once we dock there will be a delicious Cowboy-style Dutch oven dinner waiting for us.

### **Day Four: Tuesday, April 23, 2024**

Breakfast (included) at the hotel. This morning we will depart for Bryce Canyon National Park. On the way we will be visiting Capitol Reef National Park. Within the park is the historic town of Fruita, a town established by Mormon pioneers in the 1880's that was last inhabited in the early 1960's. Historic structures include the Gifford House - a one-room schoolhouse and the Behunin Cabin - a small one-room cabin where Elijah Behunin and his wife lived with 11 of their 13 children. Capitol Reef is also known for their 3,000 fruit and nut trees. Late afternoon we will arrive at the Best Western Plus Bryce Canyon Grand for our 2 night stay. Tonight's dinner (included) will be at the Cowboy's Buffet and Steak Room in Bryce.

### **Day Six: Thursday, April 25, 2024**

After breakfast (included) at the hotel, our adventure continues as we depart for Zion National Park, where we will take in all the breathtaking wonders of this enchanting park. We will have the opportunity to view the sights up close in their open-air tram as we journey through the park. Zion is the crown jewel of Utah's five iconic parks. It's landscape is filled with rainbow-colored rock layers chiseled into sharp peaks, high mesas, and deep twisting canyons. You will not forget the haunting beauty or silence of Zion's natural sandstone cathedrals, slot canyons, or the rushing Virgin River. Also, as it is April and springtime there is a great chance to view some of their majestic waterfalls fed by winter snowmelt. Next it is onto Page, AZ and our stay at the Country Inn & Suites. This evening we will enjoy a delicious Farewell Dinner at the Dam Bar & Grille. **Your entrée selection is needed at time of booking: 1) Top Sirloin, 2) Chicken Alfredo, 3) Seafood Linguine, or 4) Chef Salad.**

## New “Safe and Secure” Healthy Travel Plan

To help provide a safe and secure travel experience, Allied Tour & Travel will apply the following:

1. Our motor coach company, Arrow Stage Lines, uses an EPA Registered CURIS Decontamination System that provides a No-Touch, Whole-Vehicle delivery system which kills 99.9999% of germs so you can be confident in your Allied tour.
2. Motor coaches are cleaned with soap, water, and disinfectants after each trip. Drivers clean surfaces with disinfectants at the end of the day on multi-day tours. Hand sanitizers are available on each bus.
3. All of our vendors (hotels, attractions, restaurants, etc) are taking extra steps to provide a cleaner, healthier travel experience.
4. All passengers are encouraged to purchase the cancellation protection offered for each tour in the event you need to cancel your tour before it departs. Should you desire travel protection for after your tour departs, ask about our Travelex insurance that provides trip interruption benefits. This will protect you in the event you need to interrupt your tour after it departs due to covered health reasons. Interruption insurance helps with medical expenses should you become ill or injured while on tour and you meet the insurance criteria.
5. **Please notify us of any special needs at the time of reservation.** We will make all reasonable efforts to assist with your travel arrangements. However, it is strongly recommended that a traveling companion come along to help with any special needs of anyone with a disability. Allied tour guides have responsibilities for the entire group and can't provide one-on-one care. This includes boarding motorcoaches, airplanes, cruise ships, etc., traversing hotels, restaurants, attractions, other personal needs, etc. Contact Allied if you have any questions.
