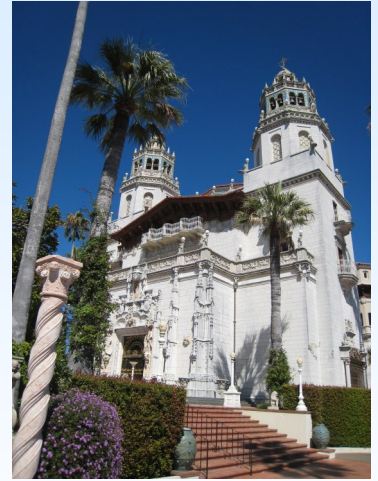
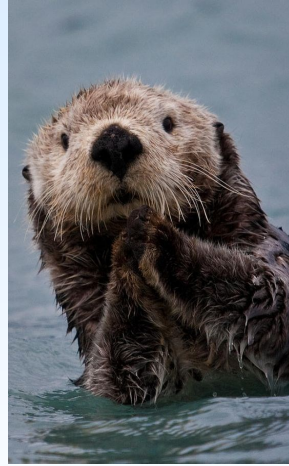

Weather in Santa Barbara & Cambria in April

The temperature averages in the mid 70's for the high and in the 50's for the low. Be sure to bring a jacket and/or sweater for any cooler weather. The dress code is casual. Please don't forget to bring comfortable walking shoes.

Day One: Sunday, April 07, 2024

Depart Sun City West, RH Johnson parking lot, aisles 8 & 9 at 7:00 AM. We are on our way to beautiful Santa Barbara. There will be rest stops and a lunch stop (on own) along the way. We will arrive at the Courtyard Santa Barbara Downtown in the late afternoon. You will have time to check-in before we enjoy a special welcome dinner (included) at the Opal Restaurant & Bar, a local favorite. Your entrée choices this evening will be Opal Arborio Risotto, Lemon Grass Crusted Fresh Salmon Filet with a Thai Curry Sauce, Grilled Chicken with Sauteed Wild Mushrooms, or a Marinated and Grilled Flat Iron Steak.

Day Two: Monday, April 08, 2024

Breakfast (included) at the hotel before departing for a docent-led tour of the Santa Barbara Courthouse where you will hear about the rich history of Santa Barbara and be able to take in the 360 degree view of the city and sparkling harbor below from their observation deck. Our next stop will be the Old Mission Santa Barbara. This picturesque landmark was founded by the Spanish Franciscans in 1786 and has been servicing the community ever since. Next we are onto Stearns Wharf where we will take in the postcard views of Santa Barbara's American Riviera and you will have some free time to explore and have lunch (on own). Next we will head to Cambria; a rural coastal town that offers rugged beaches, forested knolls and a relaxed but lively venue of bistros, wine tasting, art galleries, and specialty shops. For the next three nights we will be staying at the Cambria Pines Lodge which is nestled amongst the beauty of the Monterey Pines. The property is on 25 acres with gardens spread throughout. Each evening there is live entertainment from 6:30 to 9:30 p.m. This evening will be at your leisure to relax and enjoy the Cambria Pines or to try one of the many lovely restaurants available on their main street. The sunsets in Cambria are amazing!

Day Three: Tuesday, April 9, 2024

Breakfast (included) at the hotel this morning. Today we will visit legendary Hearst Castle and join their tour of the "Grand Rooms". The history of Hearst Castle began in 1865, when George Hearst purchased 40,000 acres of ranchland. William Randolph Hearst inherited what had grown to more than 250,000 acres, and was dreaming of ways to transform it into a retreat. The castle has 165 rooms and 127 acres of gardens, terraces, pools, and walkways. The castle was built to showcase Hearst's legendary art collection. The tour does include 159 stairs and will last approximately 1 hour. Prior to the tour you will have the opportunity to see the film "Hearst Castle—Building the Dream" on the giant screen. Lunch will be on your own at the Hearst Castle Café. Mid-afternoon we will be on our way to check out the Elephant Seal Rookery. The Rookery is a massive breeding ground for the seals that can weigh as much as 5,000 pounds. This evening we will be dining at Robins Restaurant.

Day Four: Wednesday, April 10, 2024

Breakfast (included) at the hotel. Mid-morning we will head to Opolo Vineyard, one of Paso Robles most acclaimed wineries. Their first vintage was bottled in 1999 when two neighbors had the same dream and decided to go into business together. They now produce award winning wines that you can sample while enjoying their beautiful pastoral setting. Next we are on to historic downtown Paso Robles where you will have some time to explore and have lunch (on own), before we continue on to Morro Bay. While here you will get the opportunity to visit the much photographed Morro Rock which was once known at the “Gibraltar of the Pacific, along with viewing the many seals and otters that play along the Embarcadero. Tonight is free to relax and enjoy a dinner and live entertainment at the Cambria Pines Lodge or if you would rather venture out this is your last opportunity to dine at one of their quaint eateries along main street and enjoy views of Cambria’s gorgeous beach.

Day Five: Thursday, April 11, 2024

Breakfast (included) at the hotel. This morning we will depart Cambria and head south to Simi Valley where we will be visiting the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library & Museum. You will get to explore the legacy of Ronald Reagan through a vast collection of exhibits, artifacts, and interactive displays that chronicle his humble beginnings to his Hollywood acting career, his time as California’s Governor, and ultimately, his impactful presidency. Then we are onto the Antelope Valley Poppy Reserve, renowned for its vibrant display of California poppies. In the spring the rolling hills are blanketed in a sea of brilliant orange...a photographers dream. This evening we will enjoy a pizza dinner at Bravery Brewery. You may want to try one of their popular craft beers.

To help provide a safe and secure travel experience, Allied Tour & Travel will apply the following:

1. Our motor coach company, Arrow Stage Lines, uses an EPA Registered CURIS Decontamination System that provides a No-Touch, Whole-Vehicle delivery system which kills 99.9999% of germs so you can be confident in your Allied tour.
2. Motor coaches are cleaned with soap, water, and disinfectants after each trip. Drivers clean surfaces with disinfectants at the end of the day on multi-day tours. Hand sanitizers are available on each bus.
3. All of our vendors (hotels, attractions, restaurants, etc) are taking extra steps to provide a cleaner, healthier travel experience.
4. All passengers are encouraged to purchase the cancellation protection offered for each tour in the event you need to cancel your tour before it departs. Should you desire travel protection for after your tour departs, ask about our Travelex insurance that provides trip interruption benefits. This will protect you in the event you need to interrupt your tour after it departs due to covered health reasons. Interruption insurance helps with medical expenses should you become ill or injured while on tour and you meet the insurance criteria.
5. **Please notify us of any special needs at the time of reservation.** We will make all reasonable efforts to assist with your travel arrangements. However, it is strongly recommended that a traveling companion come along to help with any special needs of anyone with a disability. Allied tour guides have responsibilities for the entire group and can't provide one-on-one care. This includes boarding motorcoaches, airplanes, cruise ships, etc., traversing hotels, restaurants, attractions, other personal needs, etc. Contact Allied if you have any questions
