Signing Up for Green Team Tee Times

I. Sign-Up Time Frames & Schedule – For all Green Team Sign-Up Google Forms that are on the Members Only page from the Green Team page on the SCW website:

- ✓ Not sure if your request went through on the Google form? Email greenteam@suncitywest.com and ask us to “look” at the spreadsheet to confirm your request.
 - ✓ Google forms **close** 2 Thursdays before the day of play and at the same time the next Google form will be posted. Exceptions sometimes apply and members will be advised.
 - ✓ Sometime during the weekend prior to the day of play, you should receive your confirming email from Data Entry/Golf Ops. This is when you will be able to see your tee time under your “My Itinerary” on your portal account and this is when the golf courses can see your tee time on their computer screen.
 - ✓ Need to cancel a tee time that you have already requested on a Google form? NOT call the golf course, **the Starters at the golf courses are not to make ANY Green Team changes.**
 - ✓ Missed the deadline on a Google sign-up form and want to request a tee time? Send an email to greenteam@suncitywest.com and include all names, all rec numbers, and your preference of 18- or 9-holes. Do NOT call the golf course, **the Starters at the golf courses are not to make ANY Green Team changes.**
 - ✓ Verify your tee time: The Green Team tee time you requested via the Google form may change. Green Team must fill in gaps in tee times and combine twosomes. Whether or not you receive a confirming email from Data Entry/Golf Ops, you should ALWAYS verify your tee time sometime during the week prior to the day of play.
- **January 6, 2024** – **Echo Mesa Golf Course – First Tee Time at 8:30 a.m.**
- This sign-up Google form has been posted on the SCW website (Member’s Only page via the GT page).
 - This Google form will close on Thursday, December 28, 2023.
- **January 13, 2024** – **Stardust Golf Course – First Tee Time at 8:30 a.m.**

- This sign-up Google form has been posted on the SCW website (Member's Only page via the GT page).
- This Google form will close on Thursday, January 4.
- **January 20, 2024 – Stardust Golf Course – First Tee Time at 11:00 a.m.**
 - This sign-up Google form will be posted on January 4.
 - This Google form will close on Thursday, January 11.
- **January 27, 2024 – First Tee Time at 11:00 a.m.**
 - Location, posting of form, and closing of form will be announced soon.

- **New Password for the "Member's Only" page**
The new password was sent via email to the 2024 continuing GT Members on December 22, 2023.
- **Green Team Changes**
The GT restructuring will begin either January 20th or 27th. It will be explained in a couple of identical presentations in the RH Johnson Lecture Hall. Dates will be released soon for GT members to sign up for one of the presentations. Members will hear about the new GT program and will be able to ask questions.
The new program was "modeled" after a national program that has over 113,000 participants with 2,800 golf professionals. This will be a wonderful opportunity for beginner golfers, and all other golfers as well, to evaluate, learn, and develop their golf skills, and share their progress in a monthly socializing event.
- **Reminders for Green Team Saturday players**
 - Arrive 30 minutes prior to your tee time on a GT Saturday.
 - Go to "On Deck" when the tee time prior to yours is called to the tee box.
 - Do **NOT** go to the tee box **UNTIL** the starter calls you to the tee box.
 - If you cannot see the group in front of you, your group is lagging. Pick up your ball and take it to the green and putt out to catch up.
 - When you are on the green DO NOT touch anyone else's ball. It is not any other player's responsibility to determine if another player has putted enough or is close enough to the hole!

- If it takes you more than 5 strokes to get to the green, do one of the following:
 - ✓ On the par 4 holes, tee off on the green tees.
 - ✓ Pick up your ball and carry it to the green.
 - ✓ Play “best ball” with your partner.
