## Signing Up for Green Team Tee Times

### **I. Sign-Up Time Frames & Schedule – For the manual GT Tee Times Sign-Up.**

#### ➤ **GT Tee Time Sign-Ups will be done manually indefinitely.**

Sign-ups will open 2 Saturdays prior to Saturday of play and will close one Saturday prior to Saturday of play and will take place in the pro shop at the course GT is playing.

At the end of play each Saturday, the manual GT Tee Time Sign-Up Book will be located at the course of play for the following Saturday. Members may sign up during the week.

An email was sent to all members the week of March 18 outlining the details.

- ✓ Manual GT tee time sign-ups will continue until the new GT Coordinator decides if manual will be permanent or if GT will go back to the Google Link.
- ✓ There will be two (2) 3-ring binders available each Saturday of play. One will have the following Saturday's GT tee time sign-up forms, and the second one will have the next Saturday's GT tee time sign-up forms.
- ✓ The deadline for signing up manually in a GT tee time sign-up book for the months of May, June, July, and August will be 9:00 a.m. on the Saturday before the Saturday of play.
- ✓ The second 3-ring binder will be available at the course of play for the following Saturday. Members may sign up during the week.
- ✓ **CANCELLATIONS:** Email [greenteam@suncitywest.com](mailto:greenteam@suncitywest.com) with your name and tee time.
- ✓ **ADDITIONS:** Go to the course of play for the following Saturday and add your name to the GT Tee Time Sign-Up Book. **BE SURE TO HAVE THE REC NUMBERS OF ALL MEMBERS YOU ARE SIGNING UP.**
- ✓ **Verify your tee time:** The Green Team tee time you requested via the sign-up book may change. Whether or not you receive a confirming email from

Data Entry/Golf Ops, you should ALWAYS verify your tee time **sometime during the week prior to the day of play.**

- **May 18, 2024 – Stardust Golf Course – First Tee Time at 11:00 a.m.**
  - Manual sign-ups will begin Saturday, May 4<sup>th</sup>.
  - Manual sign-ups will close at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 11<sup>th</sup>.
- **May 25, 2024 – NO Green Team Golf – Happy Memorial Day Weekend!**
- **June 1, 2024 – Stardust Golf Course – First Tee Time at 6:30 a.m.**


## **II. Green Team**

- Members that are ready to do the Putting Challenge should proceed as follows:
- Start at hole #1 on Stardust's practice putting green.
  - Measure 15 feet back from hole #1 and start the 9-hole round from this location.
  - Once hole #1 is completed, record your score, and start hole #2 from a location one putter length (34 to 36 inches) from hole #1.
  - Putt to hole #2 and record your score.
  - Continue this process until the 9 holes are completed.
  - If your total score is 36 or less, you are qualified to play on the course from the 25-yard checkpoint (the next challenge) on a Saturday.
  - If your score is 36 or less, report this via email to [greenteam@suncitywest.com](mailto:greenteam@suncitywest.com). Indicate you have successfully completed the putting challenge and have qualified to play from the 25-yard checkpoint.
  - ✓ Members may book their own tee time for the Saturday when they are ready to start the next checkpoint, via the manual sign-up books.

- ✓ If members are ready to start the next checkpoint **on a Saturday that the sign-up form has closed**, GT can schedule their tee time by emailing [greenteam@suncitywest.com](mailto:greenteam@suncitywest.com) and include rec number and full name.
- ✓ **Please note, the GT's sign-up forms close at 9:00 a.m. the Saturday prior to the Saturday of play.**
- If a member's score is higher than 36, they will need to re-take the putting challenge until a score of 36 or less is reached.

➤ **Green Team's Schedule**

GT's Schedule through the end of August is on the "Member's Only" page from the GT page of the SCW website.

➤ **Reminders for Green Team Saturday players**

- Arrive 30 minutes prior to your tee time on a GT Saturday.
- All GT golfers must check-in **FIRST** at the Green Team table and collect your score card; check the "Volunteer" book and sign-up to volunteer; then go to the counter to pay your green fee.
- Manually sign-up for tee times for the next 2 Saturdays **PRIOR** to going out to play golf. The following Saturday's sign-up form closes at 1:00 p.m.
- Go to "On Deck" when the tee time prior to yours is called to the tee box.
- Do **NOT** go to the tee box **UNTIL** the starter calls you to the tee box.
- If you wish to golf another 9-holes AFTER GT, and if there is a tee time available, you will pay full rate based on your membership. This additional 9-holes will be outside of the GT.

➤ **The Changeover of Green Team Coordinators**

- We are aware there are many facets of coordinating the Green Team. We have broken up the different facets. Please refer to the Email dated March 15<sup>th</sup> titled "Changeover of GT Coordinators."

➤ **Volunteers – WE NEED YOU!**

- We need a rotating "crew" of about 8 to 12 volunteers that will place the checkpoint markers/cones on Saturday mornings between 6:00 and 6:30 a.m. for the months of May, June, July, and August. Please email [greenteam@suncitywest.com](mailto:greenteam@suncitywest.com) with your availability.
