The Weather in Albuquerque

The weather in Albuquerque during October can range from 75 degrees for the average high and 45 degrees for the average low. There will be chilly mornings and evenings, so please bring a sweater and jacket, along with comfortable walking shoes. Hats and gloves are recommended.

Day 1: Tuesday, October 08, 2024

Depart SCW, RH Johnson Rec. Center parking lot, aisles 8 & 9 at 7:30 AM. There will be restroom breaks and meal stops (on own) along the way to Albuquerque, New Mexico. Arrive at the Hilton Garden Inn Albuquerque Uptown this evening and enjoy the remainder of the day at your leisure.

- 4. All passengers are encouraged to purchase the cancellation protection offered for each tour in the event you need to cancel your tour before it departs. This will protect you in the event you need to interrupt your tour after it departs due to covered health reasons. Interruption insurance helps with medical expenses should you become ill or injured while on tour and you meet the insurance criteria.
- 5. Please notify us of any special needs at the time of reservation. We will make all reasonable efforts to assist with your travel arrangements. However, it is strongly recommended that a traveling companion come along to help with any special needs of anyone with a disability. Allied tour guides have responsibilities for the entire group and can't provide one-on-one care.
