Day One: Tuesday, September 10, 2024

Depart Sun City West, RH Johnson parking lot, aisles 8 & 9 at 8:00 AM as we head out of town for some cooler temps and breathtaking scenery! Our tour guide will be including some of Sedona's must-see landmarks and vistas along with sharing the colorful history of this vibrant and artistic community. Don't forget your camera! We will enjoy a delicious lunch at the Javelina Cantina where we will dine al fresco style weather permitting. We will continue on scenic Route 89A past Oak Creek Canyon and onto Flagstaff. This stretch of road has been recognized as one of the Top 5 Most Scenic Drives in America by Rand McNally. Late afternoon we will arrive for our 2 night stay at Little America, which is nestled amongst the towering Ponderosa Pines at the base of the San Francisco Peaks. After we check-in to our hotel, you will be free to explore our surroundings and enjoy dinner (on own) at the Silver Pine Restaurant & Bar located at the hotel.
