

# Green Team 2.0 - Step-By-Step

Green Team 2.0 began Saturday, January 20, 2024, at Stardust Golf Course.

The first step for Green Team (GT) members is the putting challenge. They can start this anytime on the practice putting green at Stardust Golf Course. There are 9 “numbered” flags.

The putting challenge will be on the “honor system.” Members are to complete 9 holes on their own and record their score. The goal is to putt 9 different holes in 4 putts or less or a total of 36 putts or less for the total of the 9 holes and notify GT that you have accomplished this.

Let’s take this step-by-step to help clarify the flow of Green Team 2.0.

## **Members will start on the putting practice green at Stardust Golf Course:**

- Start at hole #1.
- Measure 15 feet back from hole #1 and start the 9-hole round from this location.
- Once hole #1 is completed, record your score. Start hole #2 from a location one putter length (34 to 36 inches) from hole #1 from either side of hole #1 or back one putter length from hole #1.
- Putt to hole #2 and record your score.
- Continue this process until the 9 holes are completed.
- If your total score is 36 or less, you are qualified to play on the course from the 25-yard checkpoint (the next challenge) on a Saturday.
- If your score is 36 or less, report this via email to [greenteam@suncitywest.com](mailto:greenteam@suncitywest.com). Indicate you have successfully completed the putting challenge and have qualified to play from the 25-yard checkpoint.
  - ✓ Members may book their own tee time for the Saturday when they are ready to start the next checkpoint, via GT’s Manual Tee Time Sign-Up Books that are available on Saturday mornings.
  - ✓ If members are ready to start the next checkpoint **on a Saturday that the form has closed**, GT can schedule their tee time by emailing [greenteam@suncitywest.com](mailto:greenteam@suncitywest.com) and include rec number and full name.
  - ✓ The Green Team Tee Time Sign-Up Book for two Saturday’s out, is available at the course during the week.
  - ✓ **Please note, the GT’s Manual Tee Time Sign-Up Book closes at 1:00 p.m. on the Saturday prior to the Saturday of play. The**

**book closes at 9:00 a.m. on the Saturday prior to the Saturday of play during the months of May, June, July, and August.**

- If a member's score is higher than 36, they will need to re-take the putting challenge until a score of 36 or less is reached.

**Each Saturday a member golfs with the Green Team:**

- Arrive 30 minutes prior to your tee time and check in first at the Green Team table and pick up your score card.
- Pay the starter at the counter your GT 2.0 Special Green Fee Rate until you reach and play from the official tee box.
- Members will be teeing off at their designated checkpoint at each of the 9 holes and will keep track of their score on the score card provided.
- Prior to golfing, be sure to sign-up for a tee time for the following 2 Saturdays via the GT Tee Time Sign-Up Books. The book for the following Saturday closes at 1:00 p.m. The book closes for the following Saturday at 9:00 a.m. during the months of May, June, July, and August.
- When members are done golfing, their partner needs to attest their score by signing the score card and placing it in the GT Score Card Box.
- If a score of 36 or less is not accomplished, the next time a member schedules a GT tee time, they will start at that same checkpoint.
- The same procedures are to be followed as above for each designated checkpoint.
