Green Team 2.0 Volunteer Opportunities

<u>Green Team Golf is a Developmental & Educational Golf Program</u> designed for golfers of varied experience and skill levels from the beginner golfer to the returning golfer.

<u>Green Team's Mission Statement</u> is to provide playing and instructional opportunities at little or no cost for new and existing golfers to learn, grow and play in a fun, safe and comfortable environment.

There are five (5) Saturday volunteer opportunities that must be filled each week. A volunteer can still golf the Saturday that they volunteer. Members working on the 25- or 50-yard checkpoints need to focus on their game and can volunteer as they progress beyond these checkpoints.

- <u>Placing Checkpoint Markers/Cones:</u> 4 volunteers are needed each week to place markers on the course 2 on the front 9 and 2 on the back 9. If these volunteers are golfing the same Saturday they volunteer, they will have an earlier tee time.
- <u>Saturday Check-In:</u> 2 members checking-in Green Team golfers on a Saturday. These volunteers can golf the same Saturday they volunteer and would take a later tee time.
- Preparing Scorecards 1 day Prior to Play and Handing Out Scorecards on Day of Play: The Scorecard Coordinators would train these volunteers. These volunteers can golf the same Saturday they volunteer and would take a later tee time.
- <u>Tee Time Sign-Up on Saturdays:</u> Assisting members as they sign-up for the following 2 Saturdays and verifying that rec numbers are correct. These volunteers can golf the same Saturday they volunteer and would take a later tee time.
- <u>Picking Up Checkpoint Markers/Cones:</u> The players in the last tee time on the front 9 and on the back 9 each Saturday will be asked to pick up the markers as they finish each hole.
- <u>Challenge Questions</u>: Monitoring the Challenge Question's Game, sorting the answers, and drawing a winner on a Saturday. Challenge Questions would only be done periodically and on a Saturday that the GT Coordinator designates.
- <u>Green Team Hat and/or Shirt Orders and Distribution</u>: Assisting this coordinator with taking orders, collecting the money, and handing out the orders on specific Saturdays. This would only take place once a year.
- <u>Annual First Swing Event in November</u>: There are various volunteer opportunities available within this annual Saturday event. The volunteers are requested annually at the beginning of October. The volunteer areas are itemized in this request.

The goal is to have several volunteers in each area and the volunteers would rotate. Snowbirds can volunteer and rotate while they are here in the busy season. These rotations would allow each volunteer to schedule which Saturday(s) works best for them, coordinate with the other volunteers in that area, and only be on the schedule once every other month.

Volunteering gives you the opportunity to meet many Green Team members that you have never met before! No matter which area you are interested in, it is flexible based on your availability. We are excited to get members involved in the Green Team 2.0 Program!
