Weather in Nashville and Memphis in April

The average temperature at this time of year in Nashville and Memphis is in the mid-70's for the high and the mid-50's for the low. The dress code is casual. Be sure to bring a jacket and/or sweater for cooler weather and comfortable walking shoes. Elevation in Nashville —597 feet

Day One: Sunday, April 27, 2025

Depart Sun City West, RH Johnson parking lot, aisles 8 & 9 at 10:00 AM with our tour guide for our shuttle ride to Sky Harbor Airport. We will arrive at the Nashville airport early evening where we will be checking into our hotel for the next 3 nights, the Drury Plaza Nashville Downtown. We are located within easy walking distance to restaurants and an abundant choice of music venues. Our hotel offers live music every evening and their popular 5:30 Kickback— complimentary evening reception including hot food items and cold beverages. Tonight we'll miss their 5:30 Kickback but you can enjoy the hotel restaurant and bar or choose to experience one of the surrounding local eateries and the music scene right outside our door.

Day Two: Monday, April 28, 2025

Breakfast (included) at the hotel before we begin our day with a city tour of Nashville. Then it is onto the Ryman Auditorium for a guided tour. The Ryman was built as the Union Gospel Tabernacle and later became home for the Grand Ole Opry, a regular live country-music radio broadcast operating since November 28, 1925 through today. It is known as the longest-running radio broadcast in US history. Next is lunch at the Loveless Café where you will enjoy some Southern style comfort food including their famous hot biscuits. This afternoon we will visit Belle Meade Plantation and Winery's rich history. We will be taking a guided-tour of this renown thoroughbred horse farm that dates back prior to the Civil War and then following the tour we will enjoy winetasting (Nashville's first and oldest winery). This evening is at your leisure and you can enjoy the hotel or choose from any of the many dining options nearby.

Day Three: Tuesday, April 29, 2025

Breakfast (included) at the hotel. This morning we will depart for a guided tour of RCA Studio B where you will have the opportunity to walk through their hallowed halls and be transported back to the golden age of music where countless chart-topping songs were created. Next we will be visiting the Country Music Hall of Fame where they offer an extensive collection of memorabilia along with interactive exhibits that bring the stories of country music's greatest stars to life. There will be some free time this afternoon to relax and have lunch or you may decide to take in the Johnny Cash Museum which is a 5 minute walk from our hotel. This evening we are off to the Grand Ole Opry! Dinner this evening will be at the Santa Fe Cattle Company where you will have a choice of Grilled Chicken, 6 oz Sirloin, Ribs, or Southern Fried Catfish so be sure to come hungry. Then it is time to take our seats at the Grand Ole Opry for an evening of great performances by country legends, rising stars, and the who's who of country music. The show will consist of 8 or more artists who will come together to perform and celebrate the past, present and future of country music for an evening to remember.

Day Four: Wednesday, April 30, 2025

Breakfast (included) at the hotel before we depart on our scenic drive to Memphis. Sit back and enjoy the Tennessee countryside as we make our way to our two-night stay at the Guest House at Graceland. Our journey today will include a visit to Loretta Lynn's Ranch, nestled in the picturesque hills of Hurricane Mills. We will step into the world of the "Coal Miner's Daughter" with a guided tour of Loretta's historic home, an antebellum-style mansion filled with personal mementos and awards. There will also be time to explore a replica of her childhood home, Butcher Holler, and gain insight into her humble beginnings. We will arrive at our hotel late afternoon with plenty of time to get checked in and ready for our evening out in Memphis. We will start with a city tour that takes us through the heart of Memphis including Beale Street. Our local guide will amuse us with live music and entertaining stories. Memphis is known as one of the birthplaces of Rock n' Roll, the Blues, and BBQ. Our next stop will showcase delicious BBQ dining at one of the cities finest, The Rendezvous.

Day Five: Thursday, May 01, 2025

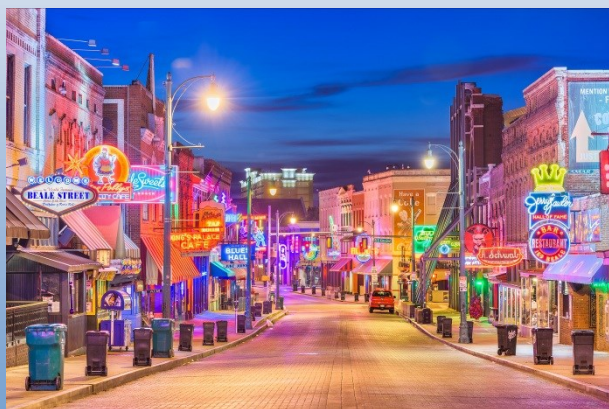
Breakfast (included) at the hotel. You've heard his music, now see the place Elvis called home. This morning we will explore Graceland; Elvis's refuge, his canvas, and his legacy. There is much to see—the beautiful mansion, the tranquil gardens, his extensive car collection, his two customized planes, and the entertainment complex which features legendary costumes, artifacts, and personal mementos from Elvis and his family. This afternoon will include visits to 1) National Civil Rights Museum - sharing the pivotal moments from the early resistance to slavery to the Civil Rights Movement, 2) Memphis Rock 'n' Soul Museum - explore stories of musical pioneers who broke racial and socio-economic barriers to create the sounds that changed the world, and 3) the famous Peabody Duck March - see the delightful spectacle as these pampered mallards waddle down a red carpet from their luxurious rooftop Royal Duck Palace to the grand lobby fountain all led by their dapper Duckmaster. For our last evening we have a special Farewell Dinner planned at the Majestic Grille, a beautifully restored 1913 movie theater. Our 3 course dinner will include the following entrée choices: New York Strip, Grilled Salmon, Chicken Marsala, or Cheese Ravioli. Bring your appetite!

Day Six: Friday, May 02, 2025

Breakfast (included) at the hotel before departing for Storytellers Hideaway Farm & Museum where you will catch a glimpse into the life of the legendary Johnny Cash. We will enjoy lunch and then explore Cash's private retreat as we stroll through the serene and picturesque grounds and his charming farmhouse which he called the "Center of My Universe". **Sandwich choice needed: 1) Homemade Chicken Salad or 2) Ham & Swiss.** Then we are onto Nashville to catch our evening flight home. Our non-stop flight on Southwest Airlines will get us back into Phoenix by approximately 9:00 p.m.

1. Our motor coach company, Arrow Stage Lines, uses an EPA Registered CURIS Decontamination System that provides a No-Touch, Whole-Vehicle delivery system which kills 99.9999% of germs so you can be confident in your Allied tour.
2. Motor coaches are cleaned with soap, water, and disinfectants after each trip. Drivers clean surfaces with disinfectants at the end of the day on multi-day tours. Hand sanitizers are available on each bus.
3. All of our vendors (hotels, attractions, restaurants, etc) are taking extra steps to provide a cleaner, healthier travel experience.
4. All passengers are encouraged to purchase the cancellation protection offered for each tour in the event you need to cancel your tour before it departs. Should you desire travel protection for after your tour departs, ask about our Travelex insurance that provides trip interruption benefits. This will protect you in the event you need to interrupt your tour after it departs due to covered health reasons. Interruption insurance helps with medical expenses should you become ill or injured while on tour and you meet the insurance criteria.
5. **Please notify us of any special needs at the time of reservation.** We will make all reasonable efforts to assist with your travel arrangements. However, it is strongly recommended that a traveling companion come along to help with any special needs of anyone with a disability. Allied tour guides have responsibilities for the entire group and can't provide one-on-one care. This includes boarding motorcoaches, airplanes, cruise ships, etc., traversing hotels, restaurants, attractions, other personal needs, etc. Contact Allied if you have any questions.
