

Green Team 2.0

Day of Play Procedures

- **Arrive 30 minutes** prior to your tee time (or sooner for practice/warm up) and **check in first at the Green Team table** and pick up your score card. If you have graduated & playing from the tee box, you will use a regular golf score card for the course.
- **Pay** your green fee with the starter at the counter.
- ***You should already have signed up for next week's event via email.***
- Sign up as a volunteer for upcoming events.
 - **Look** at your score card before you leave the pro shop as each score card will have the tee time, front or back 9, and starting checkpoint.
 - The **maximum score** on one hole is "5". If the ball is not in the hole after 5 strokes, put "5" on your score card for that hole and move on to the next hole.
 - After your round, **add up your score** and write it on the score card.
 - **Sign** your score card.
 - Have a **teammate/competitor sign** your scorecard. When you "attest" to a teammate's score, you are saying you agree with their total score.
 - **Place** the scorecard in the box provided at the check in table.
- If a score of 36 or less is not accomplished, the next time a member plays, they will continue at that same checkpoint. Once a score of 36 or less is reached, the member will advance to the next checkpoint.
- The same procedures are to be followed as above for each designated checkpoint (25,50,100 &150) until graduating to the tee boxes.

Additional Information:

- ✓ Go to the "on-deck" circle/area when the tee time prior to yours is called. Do not proceed to the tee box until the starter calls your tee time. Get ready to start (i.e. golf ball, tee, golf glove, club, ball marker, divot tool, etc.).
- ✓ When tee off from one of the checkpoint markers, you are to tee off one club length on either side of the marker or one club length **BEHIND** the marker but **no closer** to the hole. You may tee up your ball from the checkpoints or tee boxes only.
- ✓ No mulligans allowed.
- ✓ If you want to golf an additional 9-holes after golfing 9-holes with the Green Team, and a tee time is available, you will pay regular green fees and check in with the starter.
