


Notes About Voting

- Only Owner Members in good standing may vote. (Tenants and Associates may not vote).
- Each Owner Member must have their OWN email address.
- If Member Services has your email address on file from the last election, you don't need to re-register.

Please add elections@vote-now.com to your safe sender's list (you can do this by sending an email to that address before early voting starts; you won't get a response, but it will add it as a recognized address for future emails).*

If you do not receive your ballot by the end of the first day, and you have checked your spam folder, send an email with your name and rec card number to vote@suncitywest.com at least 24 hours before polls close.
